

Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children Higher Education Information Day

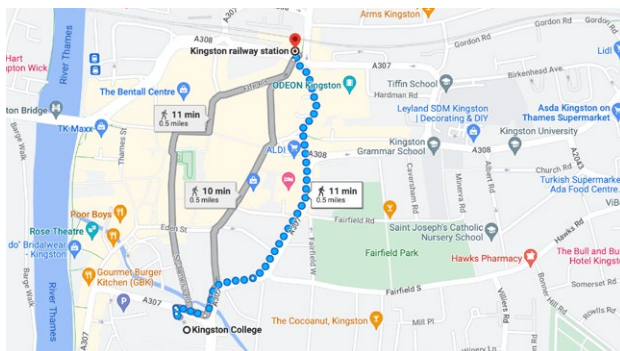
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where do I need to go?

It's being held at Kingston College, Kingston Hall Rd, Kingston upon Thames KT1 2AQ. The College is on the corner of Wheatfield Way and Kingston Hall Road, by the roundabout.

How do I get to Kingston College?

From the bus station and tube station in Kingston, the college is a 10-minute walk. Alternatively, keep an eye on the [Aimhigher London Instagram Account](#) for a short video of the walk



Where do I go when I arrive at Kingston College?

When you arrive in the reception, there will be a welcome desk and staff to greet you. Register with them and they'll show you to the room where the event will be held.

Can I bring an adult with me?

Yes, you can bring an adult with you. There will be other students who have adults with them too, for example you may want to bring a translator with you.

Do I need to bring lunch with me?

No, you don't need to bring lunch with you, unless you want to. There will be drinks in the morning and lunch will be provided. Food is halal. If you have any allergies, please do let us know in advance.
